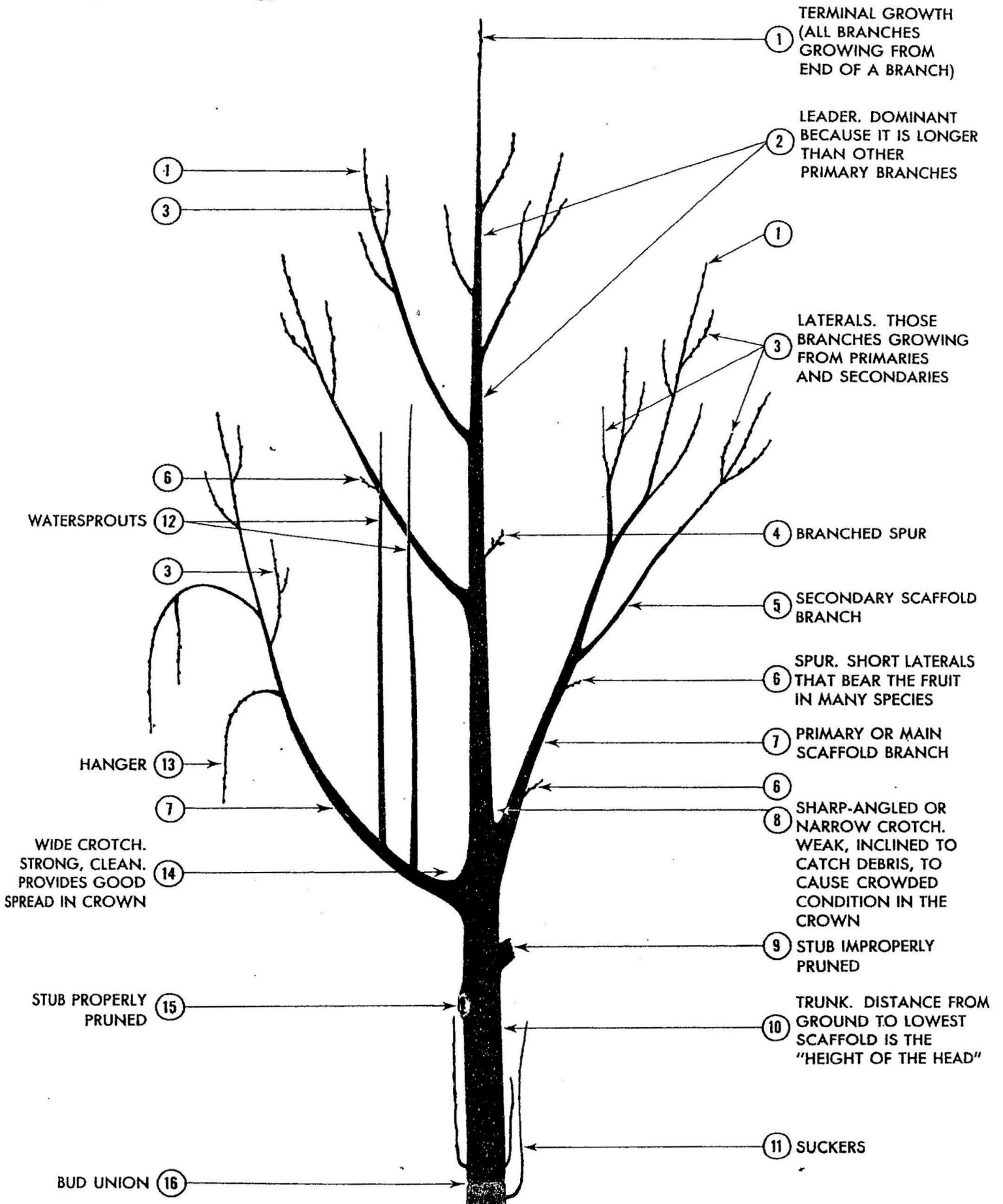


Pruning Terminology: Plant Framework



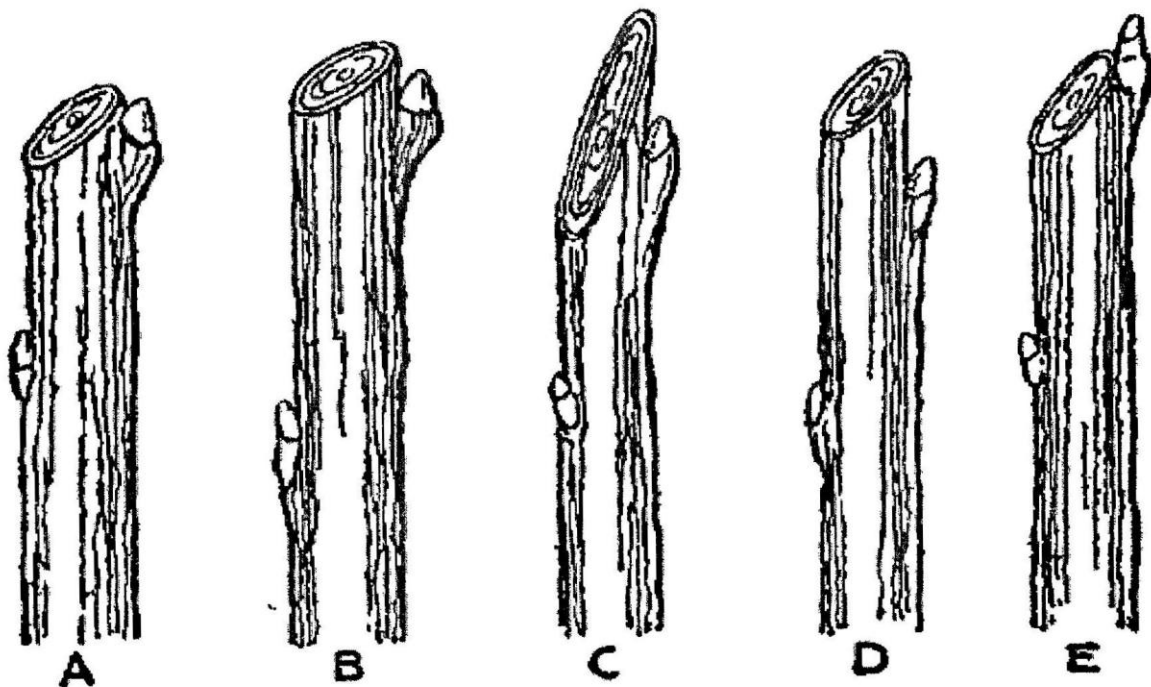

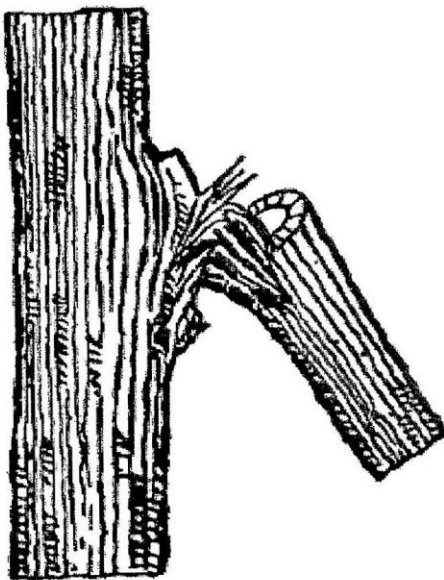

Removing a large limb: result of wrong method, attempting to do it with one cut.

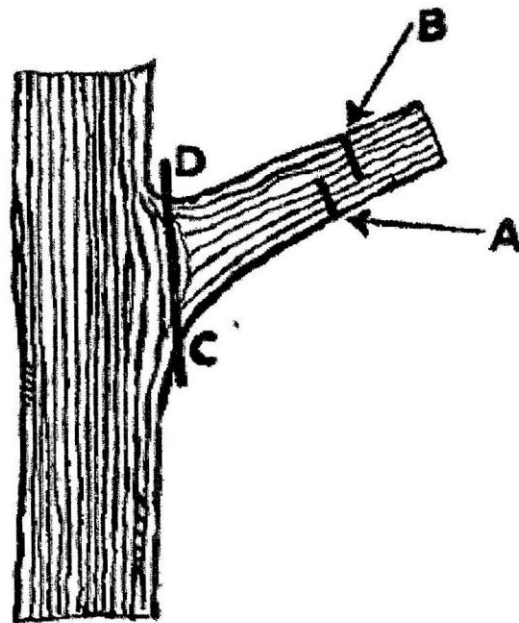
